This half-day workshop presents the IEBC Data Use Model to help your district and LCAB use data to develop plans that will improve student success.

In workshop activity sessions, you have the opportunity to reflect on your own data use (and misuse); engage in activities to immediately improve your use of data; and apply lessons to your plan.

The outcome is a new way of working that creates a partnership between the LCAB who build the plan and the district staff who implement it.

These two follow-up two-hour workshops ensure you identify measurable, actionable indicators linked in theory and practice. You will learn how to present your LCAP to audiences in ways that capitalize on recent research about how people process and use the information you provide.

The outcome is a LCAP that is actionable and has positive impact on students.
