Caring Campus uses an evidence-based coaching model wherein coaches instruct classified professionals on the fundamentals of what can be done to increase student connectedness to the college. The one-year program also guides student services and operational departments in developing strategy, which can be easily implemented campus-wide.

GETTING STARTED

Creating the Caring Campus begins with an introductory webinar, a one-year commitment, a regional kickoff, three half-day on-site meetings, college and department-specific coaching and ongoing technical support.
